



### THE RIGHT OF ACCESS TO JUSTICE IN THE CASE OF PEOPLE WHO SUFFERED GRAVE VIOLATIONS OF HUMAN RIGHTS. SOME CONSIDERATIONS ON THE JUDGEMENT *NAÏT-LIMAN*

This article is about judgement *Naït-Liman* issued by the Grand Chamber of the European Court of Human Rights on 15 March 2018. This case concerns the right of a refugee to seize a Swiss court with a civil claim for damages resulting from torture allegedly suffered in a third State, Tunisia. Like the Chamber, the Grand Chamber found that the Member States are under no international law obligation to provide universal civil jurisdiction for torture.
