## ON THE IMPACT OF THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC ON INTERNATIONAL PEACE AND SECURITY: THE CONTRIBUTION OF UN SECURITY COUNCIL RESOLUTION 2565 (2021)

Focusing on the United Nations Security Council Resolution 2565, adopted on February 26<sup>th</sup> 2021, this paper aims firstly at investigating the role played (till now) by the Security Council in the international *governance* of the Covid-19 pandemic.

Against this background, the essay also intends to highlight the contribution that the resolution seems to provide to the (on-going doctrinal) debate on the responses recently elaborated by the Security Council with respect to the so called "atypical threats" (or "global threats") to international peace and security, examining – in this perspective – the content of the 2565 resolution's text in relation to the powers and functions recognised to the Council by the United Nations Charter.
