THE DEVELOPMENT OF NEW FUNDAMENTAL RIGHTS IN THE FACE OF THE CHALLENGES POSED BY ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE, WITH A VIEW TO (RE)VALUING THE HUMAN ROLE

The paper will investigate potential new fundamental rights associated with the era of artificial intelligence. An indication of their growing recognition will also be identified in the initial regulatory proposals – at the supranational level (i.e. the European Union) and within certain national jurisdictions, including the American and French ones, selected as interesting examples – containing safeguards for their protection, which will be analyzed in depth. The potential new rights addressed are: the right to a kind of AI disclosure, that is to know the nature, human or artificial, of the interlocutor; the right to an explanation of the system's results; and the right to a minimum level of human control over technology.
