



PEACE THROUGH FORCE: THE DEMOLITION OF THE UN MODEL

This Essay examines the disruptive nature of the Trump doctrine, “peace through strength,” as a negation of the UN Charter framework, specifically regarding the regulation of the use of force, and its impact on the crisis of the multilateral global order model of international relations, subject to the norms of international law. Three recent cases, emblematic of international practice in accordance with this doctrine, will be contrasted: the Sharm el-Sheikh agreements to end Israel’s military intervention in Palestine in response to the Hamas attacks of October 7, 2023, the US Operation *Absolute Resolve* of 3th January 2026 in Venezuela, and the US-Israel Operation *Epic Fury/Roaring Lion* in Iran.
