



THE RIGHT OF THE RECIPIENT OF TEMPORARY PROTECTION TO APPLY FOR INTERNATIONAL PROTECTION FOLLOWING THE JUDGEMENT OF THE COURT OF JUSTICE IN THE CASE AA AND OTHERS C. MIGRATIONSVERKET

The article analyses the judgment of the Court of Justice of the European Union in Case C-195/25, *AA and others*, concerning the right of beneficiaries of temporary protection to submit an application for international protection. The ruling comes in the context of the activation of Directive 2001/55/EC following the massive influx of people fleeing the conflict in Ukraine and addresses coordination between emergency instruments and ordinary procedures of the Common European Asylum System. The Court clarifies that temporary protection cannot result in a restriction of the right of access to the asylum procedure, reaffirming the principles of effectiveness and judicial protection. The article critically examines the decision, focusing on its systemic implications and effects for national legal systems and for the evolution of Union asylum law.
